Subject: Re: MCA Constitution

Dear Sirs,

This has reference to your trailing email dated 12th July 2019 enclosing the corrected constitution of Mumbai Cricket Association (“MCA”).

The Committee of Administrators has perused the corrected constitution of the MCA and found that Rule 3(A)(e)(ii) of the corrected constitution MCA is not in consonance with the judgment dated 9th August 2018 passed by the Hon’ble Supreme Court. The said clause should be amended in the following manner:

CORRECTED CONSTITUTION	PROPOSED AMENDMENTS
Rule 3(A)(e)(ii) International Players Membership :- Automatic Membership shall be granted to any interested former international players (male or female), having permanent residence within MCA Jurisdiction provided he/she has not already opted for membership of another Association.	Rule 3(A)(e)(ii) International Players Membership :- Automatic Membership shall be granted to any interested former international players (male or female), <u><i>hailing from the jurisdiction of MCA</i></u> provided he/she has not already opted for membership of another Association.

You are requested to correct the said rule in the aforementioned manner.

Your attention is also drawn to the email dated 29th October 2018 addressed by the Committee of Administrators to all State Associations and email dated 3rd January 2019 addressed by the Committee of Administrators to the MCA regarding membership structure. The Committee of Administrators is yet to receive a response from the MCA to the said emails. While the issue of granting automatic membership to former international cricketers (men and women) is addressed in corrected constitution of the MCA read with further amendments communicated by the Committee of Administrators, additional amendments may be identified after considering your response (once received) on the issue of how the MCA has divorced/ separated the membership of any social club that is part of your association from the administration of cricket. Accordingly, kindly respond to the said email at the earliest in order for the Committee of Administrators to ascertain what (if any) additional amendments may be required in the MCA Constitution.
