1. Status of Compliance

In the meantime, MCA has filed intervening application before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India to put forward its views to make the provisions of the constitution workable and practicable.

Without prejudice to our above action, you are requested to please take the enclosed draft of constitution on record and give your consent to enable us to forward it to the Charity Commissioner for registration.
