Dear Sirs,

This has reference to your trailing email dated 26th July 2019, enclosing the revised constitution of Mumbai Cricket Association (“**MCA**”). The Committee of Administrators has perused the revised constitution and, has also noted that MCA has filed an intervening application before the Hon’ble Supreme Court. Accordingly, without prejudice to its stand on the said intervention application filed by MCA, it has found that the revised constitution, as submitted, is in compliance with the judgment dated 9th August 2018 passed by the Hon’ble Supreme Court. Request MCA to forward a registered copy of the MCA’s constitution to the Committee of Administrators.

MCA is hereby again requested to induct former international players (male and female) from the jurisdiction of the MCA as its members, in compliance with the provision of the revised constitution. This needs to be done so as to ensure that the former international players, who take the membership of MCA, are able to participate in the election process of MCA.

Separately, in relation to appointment of the Electoral officer, we request you to kindly refer to the Directions dated 25th July 2019 (“**Directions**”) issued by the Committee of Administrators regarding appointment of electoral officer and email dated July 29, 2019 from Committee of Administrators to all member associations directing that all Member Associations must appoint an Electoral officer in accordance with the judgment and the Directions on or before 5th August 2019.
