Dear Sir,

This is with reference to your email dated 2<sup>nd</sup> August 2019 wherein you have confirmed that the revised constitution as submitted is in compliance with the judgment dated 9<sup>th</sup> August 2018 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

In relation to appointment of Election Officer, we had intimated to you vide our email dated 26<sup>th</sup> July 2019 that the State Election Commission has nominated the following officers to conduct the MCA Elections as per Rule no. 33 of the Registered MCA Constitution:

1. Shri. Avinash Sanas Electoral and Returning Officer
2. Shri. Atul Jadhav Assistant Electoral and Returning Officer
3. Shri. Jagdish More Assistant Electoral and Returning Officer

This was not in cognizance with the Directions dated 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019 issued by the Committee of Administrators regarding appointment of electoral officer. The said directions were sent to the State Election Commission since the above mentioned officers did not meet the eligibility criteria for Electoral Officer. The State Election Commission vide its letter dated 7<sup>th</sup> August 2019 has recommended some former State Election Commissioners to be considered for the appointment of Electoral Officer which we are perusing.

Pursuant to the above, we have to inform you that the deadline of conducting the elections recommended by you will not be possible to meet. We would need 60 days to complete the process of election.
