Dear Sir,

This email is in reference to your email dated 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019 enclosing a copy of the revised constitution of Mumbai Cricket Association (“MCA”). The Committee of Administrators has without prejudice to its stand on the intervention application filed by MCA in the Hon’ble Supreme Court, perused the copy of revised constitution and has found it to be in compliance with the decision of the Hon’ble Supreme Court dated 9<sup>th</sup> August 2018 (“**Judgment**”). Further, Committee of Administrators have also perused the amendments proposed by MCA vide email dated 27<sup>th</sup> August 2019 and found them to not be in compliance with the Judgment and approval is accordingly denied in relation to the said proposed amendments. Accordingly, MCA is requested to submit a copy of the registered constitution of MCA, as approved, to the Committee of Administrators.

Separately, MCA is hereby again requested to induct former international players (male and female) from the jurisdiction of MCA as its members, in compliance with the provision of the registered constitution, and in accordance with the Protocol for Induction of Former International Players dated 14<sup>th</sup> August 2019 issued by the Committee of Administrators. This needs to be done so as to ensure that the former international players, who take the membership of MCA, are able to participate in the election process of MCA.

Your attention is further invited to directions dated 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019 (“**Directions**”) on appointment of electoral officers by the member associations issued by the Committee of Administrators, and email dated 17<sup>th</sup> August 2019 addressed by the Committee of Administrators to MCA. Accordingly, in order to comply with the Judgment of Hon’ble Supreme Court dated 9<sup>th</sup> August 2018 and Timelines and Proposed Actions issued by the Committee of Administrators on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2019, MCA is hereby again being requested to appoint an Electoral Officer by 4<sup>st</sup> September 2019 in accordance with the Directions and intimate the appointment of the same to the Committee of Administrator.
