INSTRUCTIONS FOR POLLING DAY

1. As already informed vide Election Schedule dated 14/11/2022, Polling shall be conducted on Friday, 09/12/2022 from 03:00 pm to 06:00 pm at Ground Floor, MCA Phase III Building, Wankhede Stadium.
2. Entrances of the MCA Phase III Building shall be cordoned and the surrounding areas barricaded.
3. Only the persons who are declared as valid representatives by Electoral Officer vide the Final List of Representatives & Former International Players on Election Page of MCA Website on 05/12/2022 and are carrying valid printed card with the photograph and duly stamped with the seal of the Association shall be allowed to enter the barricaded area (Rule No. 9 of Election Rule).
4. Representatives are not allowed to carry anything beyond barricade including Mobile Phones, any type of recording devices, arms / weapons etc.
5. Representatives shall undergo security check / frisking near the barricade entry.
6. Number of representatives allowed to enter the barricaded premises shall be decided by the Electoral Officer depending on the polling speed.
7. Arrangements have been made for the remaining representatives to wait in the Shaimana outside MCA Phase III Building .

8. Representatives shall enter the Polling Hall only for casting their votes and shall leave Polling and barricaded area immediately thereafter, *i.e. after polling.*
9. While casting vote, a voter should strictly adhere to following points:
 - Use only the Stamp and Stamp Pad for casting the vote as provided in every polling booth.
 - Maximum number of votes allowed in a particular category are limited to the number of seats / positions available in that category. If the number of votes casted by a voter in any particular category exceeds the number of seats in that category, then the votes casted by him in the said category shall be treated as Invalid.
 - Writing of Names, Initials, Signature or any type of identification mark on the ballot paper except the counterfoil is prohibited. If found, then the said ballot paper shall be treated as Invalid.
 - Voters should strictly observe secrecy of vote, by not displaying their marked ballot paper to anybody, not taking photograph of their marked ballot paper, not making any gesture or sign hinting about their vote etc.
10. Videography of Polling Area except the polling booths shall be done during the Polling Hours.
11. Any kind of undesirable behaviour by anybody in the barricaded area including canvassing, threats to voters, influencing the voters in any manner shall be treated as an electoral offense.
